Zone B All individuals applying directly or indirectly to EACA for membership	£20
National Association of Athletics Coaches Membership	£150

Note:

- ◆ The pricing is set sensitive to contrasting economic circumstances in **Zone A and B** Nations in Europe
- ◆ Pricing is also set to support National Associations of Athletic Coaches
- ◆ **Zone A** EAA Members are European Union nations; **Zone B** EAA Members are non European Union nations

Application Process

- ◆ Complete the online application form available at www.iaafacademy.com - Europe, proceed to send tab and enter. (Application will automatically go to EACA Membership Services).
- ◆ Where the application is for Corporate Membership a list of individual members of the National Association of Athletic Coaches should also be submitted to lorna@wa4c.com
- ◆ Individual membership applicants should provide a chosen password for membership area website access - minimum of 6 letters.
- ◆ Fee or copy of the standing order mandate whichever is appropriate should be sent to the above address.
- ◆ Correct fee must be paid by Money Order/bankers draft or standing order (please note credit/debit cards are currently not accepted)
- ◆ Fees must be submitted and received before membership is accepted.
- ◆ Once the application is accepted confirmation is sent, a membership number assigned and access to the membership area made available via the IAAF website www.iaafacademy.com
